


About the project



Workshops and activities

In order to get a general understanding of the topic, the project will begin with a introductionary session, so that the facilitators can understand the level of participants' knowledge we are starting with. During the week the youngsters will be divided in small groups, either mixed or grouped by nationality, and will be given tasks to finalize. Group reflections and time to share will be granted.

The activities will be implemented using non-formal education methodology, guaranteeing inclusion and active participation from all the young Europeans involved. Some workshops will be dedicated to the research and presentation about the art of mosaics in each of the 6 countries, while others will require the collaboration of nationality-mixed groups.

All the activities such as name games, team building games, city rally, brainstorming, theoryoriented sessions, world cafe and so on will encourage the participants to engage with each other in order to push out everyone's creativity, personality, characteristics, artistic abilities and soft skills.



Reimboursement requirements


Only travel costs that have been approved by organizers prior to booking will be reimbursed. Hence, do not buy any tickets without consulting your sending organization first. We will help you to find the most suitable and easiest option for you all.

To prove your costs you have to send to Welcome on Board NGO all the invoices, reservation and boarding passes. If you forget that, we cannot proceed with the reimbursement, if you fake any ticket your reimboursment process will be compromised. For eco-friendliness, please try to buy all your tickets online whenever possible, and keep all the original invoices. If it's on paper, keep the original and scan it in case of loss.

Only hand baggage will be refunded, if you need extra luggage you will have to pay for it, remember that it's gonna be summer time so you will need light clothes that don't require much space in a suitcase.

13/06/24 and 23/06/24 are considered as travel days. If you want to visit Palermo or other cities in Italy you can come 2 days before or after these dates. All expenses for these extra days (accommodation, food, etc.) are your responsibility.

How to reach the venue


